- Weekly Readers – Read a weekly program in the AINC studios or from home, approximately a 2 hour commitment each week
- Substitute Readers – Fill in when available for weekly readers who are on vacation or ill
- Outreach Volunteer – Assist with staffing booths at resource and low vision fairs
- Admin Volunteer – Assist with equipment distribution, program schedule mailings, listener survey calls, and other administrative tasks
